Information on the Program

Thank you for your interest in Chocolate University, an educational collaboration between Askinosie Chocolate, Drury University and Springfield Public Schools. The following details the application process and the program schedule.

- January 31th Please have all application materials submitted to Drury University Admissions Dept. Materials include the application, the admission essay, and the scholarship application (where applicable).
- February 6-9th Selected individuals will be invited for interviews with leaders of the program. These will occur after school hours, lasting approximately 15-20 minutes.
- February 10th Letters of Acceptance will be sent, along with instructions on next steps.
- February 18th An orientation session will be held in the morning. Here, we will cover the plan for the program, as well as related logistical and administrative items. Program tuition will be due at that time.
- June 23rd -
June 27th You'll be staying on the Drury University campus, with learning and leadership sessions lasting during the day.
- June 29rd-July 8th The trip to Tanzania. The lion's share of your time will be in the village of Tenende, where you'll have the opportunity to meet cocoa farmers and apply what you learned during the first week of the program.
