JANUARY 31

Please have all application materials submitted. Materials include the application, the admission essay, reference letters, and the scholarship application (where applicable).

FEBRUARY 6-9

Selected individuals will be invited for interviews with leaders of the program. These will occur after school hours, lasting approximately 15-20 minutes.

FEBRUARY 10

Letters of Acceptance will be sent, along with instructions on next steps.

FEBRUARY 18

An orientation session will be held in the morning. Here, we will cover the plan for the program, as well as related logistical and administrative items. Program tuition will be due at that time.

JUNE 23-27

Students will stay on Drury's campus for a pre-trip orientation.

JUNE 29-JULY 8

The trip to Tanzania. The lion's share of your time will be in the village of Tenende, where you'll have the opportunity to meet cocoa farmers and apply what you learned during the first week of the program.

Don't miss this exciting opportunity to travel the world and get hands-on experience in global social responsibility. Apply now for the opportunity to travel with Shawn Askinosie, Founder of Askinosie Chocolate, and visit the village of Tenende, Tanzania as a part of Chocolate University. Selected students will meet with cocoa farmers and will help implement a lunch program for students currently eating only one meal a day. This will be life-changing to learn about entrepreneurship, social responsibility and the importance of global citizenship.

In addition to Shawn Askinosie, the students will be accompanied by a Central High School teacher, a Drury professor and three Drury students. Springfield students who will be entering seniors in Fall 2012 are eligible to apply. Be sure to apply as soon as possible as there are limited spots available.

COSTS

Some **full scholarships** to cover the estimated cost of \$3,500 are available to students demonstrating financial need. This amount includes airfare from Springfield, land transportation in Tanzania, lodging, and two meals per day. Refunds are not possible once expenses are incurred.
